(Classic and Majors will bowl 3 games - Minors and Mites will bowl 2 games)

Practice and coaching will be held with children following bowling, approximately 11:00 a.m. and may vary due to availability of lanes and coaches

Fees Cost is \$35- this includes cost of Team event for City Tournament – EVERYONE BOWLS in this.

League Fees is due by Saturday, September 30th

Cost of bowling due each week that they bowl

\$3.00 per game (\$6.00 –Minors/\$9.00 Classic & Majors)

Bowling fees are collected each week that you bowl. Weekly bowling fees are to be put in the team envelope, marked and taken up to the assistant coaches. Please turn in by the 5th frame of the first game.

Parents – It will be your responsibility to assist your child to have their money for bowling. No money is owed for weeks you don't bowl.

Children's responsibility:

1. Be up to bowl when it is your turn to bowl.
2. Remain in the bowling settee area.
3. Don't stand around the ball return. Please sit in the chairs until it is your turn.
4. No food or drink in the settee area. (down by the lanes)
5. When league play is completed all bowling balls and bowling shoes will need to be put away. (That means where they came from) Thanks!
6. When league play is completed please clean up all glasses etc and take back to the counter.
7. Turn in **completed** score sheet. All totals must be added up or they won't be reported to the newspaper?
8. All season - street shoes will be left on the concourse and all coats and bowling bags will be neatly place in the bowling area.

Parents Responsibility:

1. Must stay behind the settee area (not in bowlers area)
2. Make sure that the children have their money for bowling at the start of bowling.
3. There is no smoking or drinking alcohol on the bowling concourse.
4. **PLEASE be positive** – heavy on the praise and encouragement – light on criticism. This should be fun.
5. Parents are responsible for child behavior during league play, ***misbehavior will not be tolerated.***

Code of Conduct:

1. You **will** be courteous to everyone!
2. Sportsmanship is a must!
3. No teasing
4. No Swearing
5. No hitting equipment - Anger will need to be self-contained.
6. **Misbehavior during league play will result in league discipline.**
